# Mr J Lambert – Westfield Farm Low Lane Westow, erection of a 3 bedroomed Agricultural Workers Dwelling

After discussion it was agreed that the Council reply to RDC with their reservations regarding the application ie concern re the type of brick to be used, the depth of the roof and the fact that it looked rather suburban in appearance.
